

# Beeson Farm

Woodland with a rookery. Field which is intermitently grazed by sheep and cattle. A view down to the sea.

Courtyard - swallows fly in and out of the unconverted barns. Look out for pied wagtails.

Damselflies include small red, common blue and blue tailed as well as emperor, black tailed skimmer and emperor dragonflies.

Mixed species hedgerow - hawthorn, hazel, blackthorn, ash and elder.

Typical hedgerow flowers include bluebells, red campion, cow parsley and herb robert.

Orchard - a mix of apple, pear and plum trees.

Walled garden, yew tree in centre with nesting blackbirds.

Logpile - look for invertebrates, small mammals and wrens.

Steep grassy bank, look for small mammal burrows.

Bank of snowdrops and violets.

Hedgerow trees include ash, oak, hazel, field maple, hawthorn and blackthorn.

Alder and willow trees make a good shelterbelt, look for chiffchaff and willow warbler in these trees.

Birds seen in the hedgerow include dunnock whitethroat, blackcap, yellow hammer and ciril bunting.
